## Frequently asked questions

### What types of projects are eligible for this program?

New construction projects along with additions/major renovations. Non-residential customers must apply for incentives within 180 days of occupancy or completion.

### How can incentives help my business?

Incentives can help you offset the cost of equipment more efficiently than code or industry baseline. Incentive amounts vary by project and business type, but could cover 20% or more of the additional cost.

### Who receives the incentives?

The business customer named on the PPL Electric Utilities bill is the default recipient of incentives. However, payment can be made to a third party with a signed document from the customer naming the payee.

### How do I create the calculators and complete the incentive application?

We offer one-on-one technical assistance throughout the entire process. Our team will review your plans, identify additional measures you may qualify for and help you complete the online application. Calculators can be created by our team for your project. These services are free of charge.

### When should I apply for the incentives?

If you've already started your new construction project or major renovation, it's not too late. As soon as you realize there is an opportunity, an application can be submitted online. Some measures can be submitted if they are within 180 days of completion.

### What documents are required for incentive submission and pre-approval?

Required documents can be uploaded through our online portal. They include:

1. Electrical and mechanical drawings
2. Equipment submittals or project invoices
3. Schedule of values
4. COMcheck™ results (helpful, but not required)
5. Copy of the PPL Electric Utilities bill when available
6. Signed and dated W-9 for the recipient of the incentive
